

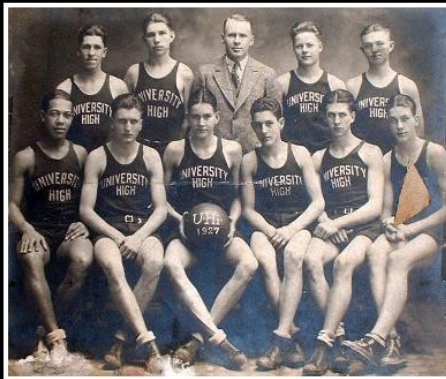
THE ONLY ONE
